- Do. You have an Emergency Plan (Readiness Handbook)
- Do you know where the nearest Assemble Area is? (DOGAMI)

What can you do to get started:

- **Neighbors Helping Neighbors** talk to your neighbors, join or start a Prepare Your Neighborhood team (https://evcnb.org/prepare-your-neighborhood)
- Involve second homeowners, they can be an important part of your team
- Be sure you have a **GoBag** located for easy access
- Get a map showing Assembly Areas and Beat the Wave map for your area (DOGAMI)
